LRS 2001

The LRS 2001 has a cutting capacity of 15cms (6") and cutting width of 2.0 metres (6' 6").

LRS 2401

The LRS 2401 has a cutting capacity of 20cms (8") and cutting width of 2.4 metres (7' 9").

REAL VERSATILITY

Both Quadsaw models are designed to be interchangeable with the head on a standard Spearhead reach mower and can add a useful service for the developing contractor to offer estate/farm customers.

Alternatively, both models can be mounted on a telescopic handler via a carriage that has an integral 3.3 metre side boom extension from the centre of the carriage. This carriage, designated HXF3300, incorporates a hydraulic safety break back of 45 degrees. The Quadsaw, complete with its carriage folds away, manually, in and out of work.



One of the biggest challenges in many of these areas is dealing with Coppices and high windbreaks. A solution is also needed whenever the task is beyond the effectiveness of a standard flail in terms of limb thickness. In the UK, the demands of the Countryside Stewardship Scheme call for innovative and effective design. QUADSAW, with its proven circular saw concept is the answer in dealing with hedges that have been allowed to remain untrimmed for three or more years.

THE CONCEPT

The QUADSAW is four circular saw blades mounted, in-line, to give a cutting capability of limbs up to 20 cm (8"). Two models are available.
